Ordinary Full Membership	€305.00		Ordinary members will be aged 18 years and over. They shall have all rights, privileges and obligations as laid down in club regulations.
Family Membership	€430.00		This category shall be comprised of a couple and their children and/or children under their guardianship who are aged under 18years. They shall enjoy full rights and privileges within the boundaries of the club and the children shall be deemed to be junior members.
Senior Membership	€115.00		This category will apply to members who have been ordinary or Family members for a minimum of 10 years. The minimum age for entry into this category shall be 65 years.
Cadet Membership	€70.00		This membership may apply to persons between the ages of 18 years and 25 years who are in full time education.
Junior Membership	€56.00		This membership shall apply to persons between the ages of 10 years and 18 years.
Crew Membership	See Notes		This membership shall apply to persons who actively crew on club members boats. It may be availed of only once and at the end of 3 consecutive years the member shall automatically become an Ordinary member at the Ordinary membership rate. Pavilion Membership	€70.00		This category of membership is available to persons who wish to associate themselves with the club in a social capacity.

**INTRODUCTION TO MEMBERSHIP**

Currently membership applications are being taken and an introduction scheme is available to new visitors to provide access to affordable sailing.

**NOTES ON MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION**

1. Membership of this club is bound by its rules, policies and procedures, which are available on request from the Clubhouse.
2. Crewmembers must become Full members after 3 consecutive years as Crew members.
3. Crew membership may only be availed of once.
4. Regular crew must also be paid-up full members.
5. All categories of Membership of the Club are open to Men and Women. Membership is by election at a Committee Meeting following proposal and secondment by existing members of the Club.
6. Family membership entitles the applicants children who are noted on this form and all future renewal forms, (up to 18 years) to Junior membership and their inclusion on all form will be deemed to be a note of permission required for junior members.
7. Family members are entitled to 1 vote per adult (max 2) provided each party have been named on application form.
8. All crewmembers must provide, annually, details of the boat on which they are crewing and their Skipper must endorse their renewal form.
9. Crewmembers must participate actively and regularly in club sailing events and the club reserves the right to withdraw crew membership from any person not actively and regularly participating in sailing events and activities.
10. A Junior member, on reaching 18 years, may become a Full member without incurring the initial joining fee. This application must be made within the year on which the birthday occurs.
11. All new members are subject to a 12-month probationary period.
12. Crewmembers cannot vote at club meetings.
13. Associate members cannot attend or vote at any club meetings.
14. Access to certain areas is restricted according to the type of membership held.
15. There is a replacement charge for any lost, broken, stolen etc, access cards.
16. Lost access cards must be reported to the General Manager immediately.
