**This regatta is open to all secondary school pupils who sail.
All sailors will be acknowledged as representing their school at yachting.
Entry will be available online.
Entries will be accepted online only, at College Sport.
ENTRIES ON THE DAY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

DATES: Monday 5th March and Tuesday 6th March 2018.

RULES: 420's will not be permitted to carry spinnakers.
For the Techno Board's the following sails must be used.
Under 17yrs: 7.8 or 6.8 only, Under 15yrs: 6.8 or 5.5 only

ENTRIES: Each school may enter any number of 420, Starling, Optimists, P-Class, Laser, Laser Radial, RSX/Techno, RS Feva, Sunburst Classes. Boats may be all of one or an assortment of all or any of the classes listed.

- Entries will close **26th February 2018** with ASB College Sport. **Entries will be available online from 1st February 2018.**
- All entrants must be full time students of a secondary school in the Auckland Region and under 19 years of age at the 1st Jan in the year of competition.
- Briefing 0930hrs
- Racing commences 1030hrs, Thursday 1st March 2018.
- Racing commences 1000hrs, Friday 2nd March 2018.
- Entry Fee is \$25.00 per sailor (\$38 per two handed boat)
- Up to three races may be sailed back to back on each day.

SCORING:

There will be a maximum of 6 races. A minimum of 2 races will constitute a series. If 6 races are sailed the worst race will be dropped.

Boats with 2 crew members: The two crew members may be from different eligible schools and for team points each sailor will be awarded 60% of that boat's total score. This score is eligible for team points.

The Team for the Overall winning school at this Annual Fleet Racing Regatta and winner of the EPIGLASS Trophy will consist of the three best scoring boats from 3 different classes plus the next best scoring boat from any one of the 3 classes. *To win the overall school trophy (the EPIGLASS TROPHY) at the fleet racing regatta a school will need to enter **one boat in three different classes –420, 29er, RS Feva, Sunburst, P-class, Starling, Optimist, Laser, Radial and RSX/Techno** plus one additional boat in any one of these ten classes. Four boats to count for a team score.*

Teams in each class are the two top scoring boats from one school in that class.

PRIZES: There are trophies for the overall winning school, and the Individual and team winners in each class, ASB Medals will be awarded to 1st and 2nd in each class. Trophies will be given for each class. Any trophies not return to College Sport before the next regatta will be charged to the school.
