NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the RRS, the prescriptions of Irish Sailing, the rules of the International Mirror Class Association of Ireland (IMCAI), this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any amendment thereto.
- 1.2 All Mirrors and competitors shall comply in full with the insurance and safety requirements of the IMCAI. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €3,000,000 per incident/event or the equivalent.

2. Advertising A boat and her crew shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The event is open to Mirrors sailed by members of the IMCAI or, where non-resident on the Island of Ireland, the Mirror Class Association of another country.
- 3.2 Single event membership of the IMCAI is available.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form which can be downloaded from www.cybc.ie. Payment will be accepted on the morning of registration. Entry fee is €50 per boat.
- 3.4 For registration to be valid you must complete the entry form, have it signed by all required parties, and have paid the required entry fee.
- 3.5 Each boat may be asked to produce a valid measurement certificate at registration.

4. Registration and Schedule of Races

- 4.1 Registration shall take place at the Club House from 11.00 hrs to 11.45 hrs on Saturday 5th May. Sailing Instructions and details of the social programme will be available to competitors at registration, and may, where possible, be posted on the IMCAI (www.mirrorsailingireland.com) and CY&BC websites (www.cybc.ie) one week in advance of the regatta.
- 4.2 Measurement, examination of measurement certificates and/or measurement checking may take place as part of the registration process.

- 4.3 A briefing will be held at 12.00 hrs on the first day of scheduled racing in the Club House.
- 4.4 Six races are scheduled for the event; four races on Saturday, two races on Sunday. The scheduled time for the warning signal for the first race is 13:30 hrs on Saturday; this changes IMCAI Championship Sailing Instruction rule 6.2. The scheduled time for the warning signal on the second day of the event will be 14.00 hrs on Sunday. The second and subsequent race(s) on each day will commence as soon as possible after the completion of the previous race.
- 4.5 In the event of adverse weather conditions, the race committee reserve the right to sail extra races on either day of the regatta.

5. **Race area and courses**

Details of the race area and courses to be sailed will be available at registration.

6. **Lunches**

Lunches will not be provided to competitors on the water.

7. **Prizes and prizegiving**

Prize giving will be held in the Clubhouse as soon as possible after racing on the Sunday. Mirror Northern Championships 1st, 2nd & 3rd; Silver Fleet 1st; Bronze 1st, 2nd, 3rd. Selection of boats into the above fleets will be done by the IMCAI

8. **Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

9. **Rights to Use Names and Likenesses**

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to the event. They also allow their names, age category, club and boat details to be displayed in competitors lists prior to the event and in results, both on the CY&BC and IMCAI websites and in other publications.
