Code of practice for Junior Members

The following guidelines are expected to be adopted by all Junior Members sailing as members of Budworth Sailing Club

All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants, regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.

Unfair play and arguing with officials is not to be tolerated. Accept officials' judgements

Recognise good performance, not just results, and applaud efforts made.

Accept responsibility for your own performance and behaviour

Use correct and proper language at all times.

Ensure that instructions are followed and agreed timings are kept – inform the instructors if there may be problems.

Be supportive of the Club officials and Instructors – help them whenever you can, and remember, they are giving up their time to help and support you in developing an interest and expertise in Sailing.

Ensure that membership and other fees are paid promptly and you turn up with the right kit and equipment

Remember that buoyancy aids or lifejackets must be worn whenever you are on a jetty or in a boat

Everyone must adhere to Club Rules and safety requirements and must not indulge in inappropriate activities whether on the Club Premises or representing the Club elsewhere.
