Risk Management

1 Principle

During organised sailing or Club events at Budworth, procedures are in place so that in the event of an accident or incident which could give rise to injury to people or property or adverse comment inside or outside the Club, an appropriate course of action can be initiated which will minimise the risk to all concerned. The existence of these procedures should be well known within the Club and their content understood, at least by the members of the Committee. The procedures are available within the Club in the form of hard copy, kept in the ODs box, and from time to time should be practiced, audited and amended so as to ensure effective operation and implementation should the need arise. The emergency procedures are also available through the Club website.

2 Person in Charge

The Principal Race Officer or Officer of the Day (PRO or OD) is the official Club representative who is in charge of activities during organised racing. At other officially organised events the event organiser or a senior member of the Committee would be seen as the person with overall responsibility for the activities of the Club at that time, and should be recognised as the “OD” for that event

In the event of any serious or potentially serious event occurring at the Club or during Club activities, the Commodore must be notified as soon as practicable, and informed of the actions that have been taken.
