### NOTICE OF RACE

#### ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Boats as listed below under 'STARTS' are eligible to enter. A boat may be entered by a member of a club or other organisation affiliated to a national authority. All entries should be on the entry form attached and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

#### SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSES

The Race Office will be open as follows:

Saturday 14th July	0930hrs – 1500hrs
Sunday 15th July	1000hrs – 1300hrs

CY&BC, its officers and agents accept no responsibility for any damage to boats or for personal injury occurring while afloat or ashore. Competitors' attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 4, especially in relation to races being run in heavy weather. All those taking part in this event do so at their own risk and responsibility. The organisers shall not be responsible for the seaworthiness of a boat whose entry is accepted or for the sufficiency or adequacy of its equipment. The organisers shall not be responsible or liable for any injury to persons or damage to property either ashore or afloat which may result from participation or intended participation in this event.

#### MEMBERSHIP

All competitors will be granted honorary membership of Clontarf Yacht & Boat Club for the duration of the event.

#### STORAGE OF BOATS

Storage for competitors' boats will be available on Club property for the duration of the event only.

#### SAILING AREAS

The Sailing areas shall be North of the entrance to the bay between Clontarf and Sutton and within the harbor area for the dinghy races starting from Clontarf. Yachts racing from Dun Laoghaire or Howth should keep their usage of the shipping channel to an absolute minimum.

#### LOCAL VARIATIONS

Yachts are advised that a tidal wall exists between the statue and the Green Light House which is covered at full tide. It is hazardous to cross this at any time. Deep keeled boats should exercise caution when anchoring and are advised to weigh anchor before HIGH WATER plus two hours.
