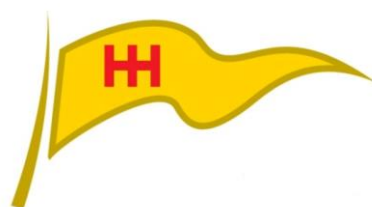

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organising Authority

Hill Head Sailing Club.

2. Rules

2.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2.2 The Organising Authority implements the RYA Racing Charter. Competitors shall undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020) or at <http://www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter>

3. Eligibility

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a PY number.

3.2 All helms should be current members of one of the three participating sailing clubs.

4. Registration

4.1 Eligible boats shall enter on the day by completing the sign-on form available at the competitor's home club.

4.2 It is the responsibility of the home club to provide the list of their competitors to the organising club, before the start time on race day. Please could a club representative bring along their club sign-on sheet and provide to the Race Officer on race day.

4.3 All competitors are to detail Emergency Contact Details on the sign-on sheet.

4.4 All visitor helms and crew under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent / Guardian Declarations at registration. Responsible person for cadets must be present during the event.

5. Fees

5.1 Entry fee: Free

6. Briefing

6.1 Each club shall ensure that their sailors are briefed. Any competitor needing support in understanding any details should seek clarification from a club official before taking to the water.

7. Schedule

7.1 There will be 1 race.

7.2 The target duration of race will be 60-75 minutes for the first boat.

7.3 Details are as follows:

8. Sailing Instructions

- 8.1 Sailing Instructions including course, will be available on the day and on the HHSC website.

9. Race Area

- 9.1 The race area will be on The Solent, directly in front of the sailing club.

10. High Water

- 10.1 15:50 (4.6 metres)

11. Media Rights

- 11.1 Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

12. Disclaimer of Liability

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.
- 12.2 Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat and its helm is fit to sail in the conditions that they might find. By launching or going to sea competitors confirm their boat is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organizers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organizers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event and include the organizing authority, race committee, race officer, safety officer, patrol boat personnel and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.

13. Insurance

- 13.1 Each participating boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance cover of at least £2,000,000 against third party claims.
