

Bosham Sailing Club Regatta Saturday 10 July 2021

Notice of Race

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The organising authority is Bosham Sailing Club ('BSC'), The Quay, Bosham, West Sussex PO18 8LU.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* ('RRS'), the notice of race (NoR) and the regatta sailing instructions (SI). By entering the regatta, competitors agree to be bound by the RRS and all other rules that govern the regatta.
- 2.2. The RRS that are changed and/or amended together with the applicable SI are as follows: RRS "Race Signals" (SI 1.2), RRS Part 4 preamble and RRS 40 (SI 4.5 & 5.1), RRS 27.3 (SI 4.4), RRS 32.1 (SI 6.4), RRS 29.2 (SI 7.6), RRS A4.1 (SI 7.7), RRS 63.1 (SI 10.2), RRS 35 & A4.1 (SI 11.), RRS 44.1 (SI 9.1), RRS 63.7
- 2.3. This NoR and the SI may be amended by a notice to competitors displayed on BSC's website. If there is any conflict with a sailing instruction, the sailing instruction shall prevail. This changes RRS 63.7. If there is any conflict between the NoR or the SI displayed on BSC's website and the written versions that may be available at the pre-race briefing, the written versions shall prevail.
- 2.4. Competitors and their families must read, understand, and then comply with all government and RYA guidance in respect of Covid-19 before attending the event. Non-adherence may lead to offending competitors being withdrawn from the event by the organising authority with no redress

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. The Regatta is open to all classes listed in the race programme set out in this NoR.
- 3.2. Eligible boats must enter using the online registration system on the BSC website: <https://www.boshamsailingclub.com/event/bsc-regatta>. Entries are accepted until 11.00 on the day of racing.
- 3.3. Entry fees are as follows:
 - Double-handed dinghies £15
 - Single-handed dinghies £10
 - Keelboats & three-handed £20
- 3.4. Craft not displaying a Chichester Harbour plaque will require a day permit (£2, available online at registration).
- 3.5. All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit a signed parent/guardian declaration form at registration.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. One race for each class is scheduled, except race 12 for Optimists.
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the start for each race is detailed in the race programme in this NoR.
- 4.3. Races 1, 2 & 3 will finish at Bosham Quay, unless the course is shortened to finish at the Gallon Line by a committee boat, in the event that the wind is over 15 kts as provided by SI 1.2 and 5.5.

- 4.4. Two or more classes are sharing starts for races 4, 6, 7 & 9. Results will be separated by class, subject to there being a minimum of three starters in each class.
- 4.5. Boats eligible for a class event will not be accepted in a handicap race, unless there are less than three starters in the class.
- 4.6. Handicap ratings must be agreed for individual entries by Friday 9th July. Boats without a 2021 PN or BSC handicap please contact the BSC Office. BSC boats please contact their Class Captain.
- 4.7. Race 12 The Optimist race(s) will be run in the pool north of Bosham Quay and organised by the Optimist class captain's nominee.
- 4.8. The race committee reserves the right to cancel any races that have less than three entries. Remaining entries may transfer to handicap race 4, 7 or 9 depending on PN.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6. PRIZES

- 6.1. Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries.
- 6.2. All trophies awarded remain the property of BSC and shall be returned immediately to the club on request. The holder (or their parent/guardian) is responsible for the safekeeping and adequate insurance of the trophy and for returning the trophy to the club office on request of at a date designated by the club. No trophy may be taken outside of the UK

7. RIGHTS TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESS

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the Regatta.

8. RISK STATEMENT

Rule 4 of the RRS states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue to race is hers alone". Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- 8.1 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- 8.2 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 8.3 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- 8.4 Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- 8.5 The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, if any, and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- 8.6 The provision of patrol boat cover if any is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can practically be provided in the circumstances;
- 8.7 It is their own responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event; and
- 8.8 Their boat is adequately insured and in particular, with cover of at least £3,000,000 against third party claims.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY & INDEMNITY

- 9.1. Without prejudice to paragraph 8 above BSC shall not be liable (whether in contract, tort or howsoever otherwise) for any loss, damage, death or personal injury (other than death or personal injury arising from the negligence of BSC) to the owner/competitor, his or her

crew nor any damage caused to other yachts whether participating or not, as a result of their taking part in the event

- 9.2. Every owner and competitor participating in the event undertakes to indemnify BSC against any claim that may be brought against it arising out of his or her negligence or default whilst participating in the event.


