

Covid 19 precautionary measures during your Powerboat Level 2 (PB2) course at the SGBA

Risk of virus transmission exists from exhaled droplets and contaminated surfaces.

To minimise the risks of transmitting Covid 19 we need all attending to adhere to the following routines for personal safety and that of others.

We can only minimise risk and cannot remove it, so it is important that all participants recognise that a risk of contamination still exists and that they are prepared to take that risk in attending the course.

Students or instructors must not attend the course if they have any Covid 19 symptoms and must advise the SGBA if they suffer any Symptoms in the 10 days following any course.

On board boats:

Students and instructors must take the following precautions on board the boats:

- Face forward where possible and outward when changing position on the boat
- Use seats as directed by the instructor

Students and instructors must take the following precautions on board the boats to minimise risk of contaminating surfaces:

- Use hand sanitiser on boarding the boat

Theory sessions ashore:

Theory sessions will be held in the training room with balcony all doors open to maximise ventilation. Students and instructors must take the following precautions:

- Bring warm clothing in case the extra ventilation will make the spaces cold
- Use hand sanitiser regularly
- Wear face coverings where appropriate
- Follow instructions on notices for use of toilet / washroom.

Please bring sufficient drinks and, of course, your own packed lunch for both days.
